Consumable Products			This billing item applies when one time use products used at accident recoveries are used and are paid at product cost subject to a 15% markup which include items such as:  • flares  • absorbent material  • protective covers/wraps/tarps  Note: The markup costs are not applied when a purchase discount has been provided
